If you are utilizing back door service, we ask that you place your trash can visible from the street near the location that you will be utilizing, to allow the crews to become familiar with the neighborhood. Below is a “Quick Pick Up Guide”. QUICK PICK UP GUIDE

New Pick up days:

Wednesday trash collection with recycling

Saturday trash collection with 1 bulk item at the curb

Homeowners will use current trash containers

Have Trash and Recycling out by 7:00 A.M.

Stickers will be distributed to homeowners to place on their current recycling containers

Trash



- Please make Trash Cans Visible for crews to see.
- Yard waste, and bulk items will be collected **curbside**. Limit **10 bags** of yard waste.
- Trash and yard waste must be bagged and weigh less than 40 pounds.
- All branches and tree trimmings should be no more than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet in length and bundled together. Bundles must be securely tied and weigh less than (40) forty pounds each.
- One bulk item to be placed at the curb on Saturday
- Holidays observed are: New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a regularly scheduled service day, there will be no service that day. Service will resume on the next scheduled collection day following the holiday.

Excluded Items:

Recycling



- **Paper** – magazines, newspapers, copy paper, phone books, junk mail, etc.
- Plastic **#1 through #7**– juice, water, milk, soda, detergent, cleaners, RX bottles. (Please check the bottom for the recycling symbol)
- **Aluminum** – any type of soda beer or drink can, etc. **(PLEASE RINSE OUT)**
- **Tin Cans** - any food can, pet food can, etc. **(PLEASE RINSE OUT)**
- **Cardboard** – boxes, cereal, food, detergent, pet food, etc.
- **Glass** – any color glass. Must be pure glass.
- **Thin Plastics** – bags from grocery, sleeve on newspaper, wrapping on dry cleaning – **bags MUST be tied together and put into another bag. NO LOOSE BAGS**
- Additional recycling material may be bagged in clear trash bags.

Excluded Items:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● It is illegal to transport any hazardous waste in a trash truck and dispose of it in a landfill. Hazardous waste includes: medical waste, toxic or radioactive waste, any appliance containing Freon, acids, car batteries, dead animals, and chemicals of any kind, car parts, car tires, and construction trash (includes concrete, large quantities of carpeting, fencing, rolls of carpet or any construction type material or debris). ● Other excluded items include: Large pieces of glass (must be broken down in smaller pieces and placed in a closed box and labeled), metal items, improperly contained animal waste (animal waste must be placed in a sealed bag to be serviced). ● CFC (Freon) items are no longer acceptable items at the landfills, so we are no longer able to pick up refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other item containing Freon. ● Excluded Liquid Waste - Toxic or radioactive waste, Freon, paint, acids, petroleum products or filters are not accepted, cooking oil, or chemicals of any kind. ● Bulk items which are too large for Contractor to put in with the normal weekly pickup may be collected separately upon request.
